2024-25 Winter Shelter at OSLC/OSSH

The 39th year of Room in the Inn's Winter Shelter Program concluded on April 1st. This was the 5th consecutive year that OSLC hosted an increasing number of our homeless neighbors! During the 2024-25 Winter Shelter season, OSLC/OSSH's 22 innkeepers and 92 meal servants graciously showed 575 guests (A new single season record here at OSLC/OSSH and +5% higher than last season) radical hospitality and most importantly welcoming fellowship! There is a reason Nashville's homeless love coming to OSLC, and all of you - innkeepers, meal servants, donors, or prayer supporters are it! Praise be to God for your servant hearts and bringing glory to His Name!



Our homeless ministry focus will now shift to Spring/Summer cookouts at Room in the Inn for their facility bound residents and re-stocking our Clothes Closet for the 2025-26 Winter Shelter season. Our greatest needs include:

Church Elders

These friendly folks are stationed near each of the main exits of the sanctuary. If you should have a question or need assistance during service feel free to approach one of them.

Restrooms

When entering the lobby from the sanctuary, restrooms are to the left, at the end of the lobby on the right.

Family Foundations Room (Cry Room)

This is a space for families to come and help their little ones to learn how to be a part of church! If they're having some trouble in the sanctuary, feel free to come in here and cry it out, get some wiggles out, and read a book (rotated and sanitized after every service) to help them be calm and learn more about God and being a part of his church! This room is located on the right end of the foyer when exiting the Sanctuary. It is furnished with rocking chairs, a private restroom, and windows/speakers so that you can still hear and view the service.

The Lord’s Supper

In Holy Communion our Heavenly Father promises anew His unconditional love, renews His pledge of forgiveness in Christ, offers His Holy Spirit as strength for daily faith and life. The Scriptures tell us we are to examine ourselves before taking The Lord’s Supper (I Corinthians 11:27-32) You are invited to commune with us if you can say “yes” through the gift of faith to the following:

- + . I am a Baptized Christian and I trust in Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.
- + . I am a sinner in need of God’s forgiveness.
- + . I believe that Christ is truly present with His Body and Blood in, with, and under bread and wine offering me forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation.
- + . I will live in the strength of the Holy Spirit to God’s glory, in ministry with His people, in mission to His world.

- Non-alcoholic wine is available for those with special needs. It is the white wine in the center of the individual cup trays. We also have Gluten Free Option. We welcome young children who have not yet been instructed about communion to come forward for a blessing.

If you have questions about communing, please speak with the Pastor prior to the service.
